Sacrament of Baptism: is scheduled by appointment only; parents must have been registered members of the parish for at least 2 months and must participate in Baptismal Instruction (offered on the 1st Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. in the Bride's Room).

Sacrament of the Sick: In the event of serious illness or medical emergency, Anointing and Eucharist may be arranged. Call the parish office during office hours, or the emergency number after hours. Contact the Visitation Ministry Office to arrange for home visits.

Celebration of Christian Funeral: After the death of a loved one, you may contact the Parish Office at your earliest convenience to arrange for a date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Sacrament of Marriage: Engaged couples requesting information about matrimony must contact and meet with one of the priests or deacons at least 4 months before the proposed wedding date and should expect to participate in a marriage preparation program.

Christian Initiation of Adults: Adults requesting information about full initiation into the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation) may contact the RCIA Coordinator at 371-0994.

Christian Initiation of Children (CIC): We offer a program for older children who have not been baptized or received their First Communion. Call the Religious Education Office at 946-1154 for information.

Spiritual Practices

Ignatian Spirituality:

Palm Sunday reminds us how fickle we are. We too might be praising Jesus as King and laying down palm fronts for him one minute, and demanding he die, (or at least leave us alone) in the next. During Lent, we prayerfully consider three things: 1) how Jesus suffered in his humanness, 2) how he hid his divine power, and 3) how he was betrayed, imprisoned, groundlessly convicted, and murdered. There are terrible events. This prayer is a death watch. And we might be tempted to escape or avoid the pain. But one thing is certain, we pray through the passion out of love for Jesus our Savior and King. And in this period, we ask for the grace to stand by Christ, to stay in the moment, and to suffer with him. It's not an easy grace to ask for.




