

Sacrament of Baptism: is scheduled by appointment only; parents must have been registered members of the parish for at least 4 months and must participate in Baptismal Instruction (offered on the 1st Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. in the Bride's Room). Registration for the class is required.

Sacrament of the Sick: In the event of serious illness or medical emergency, Anointing and Eucharist may be arranged. Call the parish office during office hours, or the emergency number after hours. Contact the Visitation Ministry Office to arrange for home visits.

Celebration of Christian Funeral: After the death of a loved one, you may contact the Parish Office at your earliest convenience to arrange for a date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Sacrament of Marriage: Engaged couples requesting that their wedding take place at Christ the King must fill out an application (available on our website or in the parish office). The application must be submitted at least 4 months before the proposed wedding date to allow time for marriage preparation. The form includes information about fees.

Christian Initiation of Adults: Adults requesting information about full initiation into the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation) may contact the OCIA Coordinator at 371-0994.

Christian Initiation of Children (CIC): We offer a program for older children who have not been baptized or received their First Communion. Call the Religious Education Office at 946-1675 for information.

Today's first reading, from Sirach, is not directly referenced in the Rule of St. Benedict, but humility surely is! Chapter 7 of the Rule, Humility, is the longest of the chapters; it cites today's Gospel: 'whoever exalts himself shall be humbled, and whoever humbles himself shall be exalted.'

St. Benedict illustrates growth in humility as a ladder. Sometimes we take steps up, and sometimes we step down. Growth in humility, in holiness, isn't a one-way street and our missteps help us learn.

Carmelite Corner

Excerpts from *Nine Themes in Carmelite Spirituality*, Fr. Patrick McMahon, O. Carm., www.ocarm.org

Carmel is Marian

We belong to Mary. But if you notice, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel is always depicted as holding the Child Jesus. Carmelites love Mary and honour her as the one who introduces us to Jesus. Strangely Mary is never mentioned in The Rule of St. Albert, the document that initially defines Carmel and its spirituality.... Yet she is always present in the Carmelite tradition and her presence, though somewhat inconspicuous, is fundamental

When Mary is present in the Carmelite writings she is almost invariably eclipsed by her Son. It is a reminder that even though we cannot see the moon when the sun is shining, the moon is always there, and it draws its light from the sun. In the same way, Carmelites remember that while our sight is focused on Jesus, Mary is still there. Like the moon she sheds not light of her own, but reflects the Light from her Divine Son.

For us Carmelites, the principal sign of our devotion to Mary is imitation. And the outward manifestation of our Carmelite devotion to her is the Brown Scapular.... Many Carmelites find Mary and prayers and devotions such as the Rosary tremendous helps in their spiritual life. And the Order encourages us in this devotion.


