Surviving Divorce: (12 Sessions- Ascension Press) Monday Nights, 6:30PM- 8:30PM in the Youth Center, Rm. B- - Starts on Sept. 18th

Surviving Divorce was created to bring hope and healing to those who have experienced the pain and loneliness of a broken marriage. It is for the newly separated and divorced and those still struggling with issues many years later. It will help them answer their questions, restore hope, and begin authentic healing. Developed and hosted by Rose Sweet, Surviving Divorce features experts Dr. Ray Guarendi, Ph.D., Fr. Donald Calloway, M.I.C., Fr. Steve Porter, S.T.L., Fr. Mitch Pacwa, S.J., and Christopher West. It also includes personal testimonies of Catholic men and women who have experienced the breakdown of their families. They courageously share their stories with heart, humor, and wisdom. Cost: \$20

Walking Toward Eternity- Daring To Walk the Walk, Part 1: (8 Sessions- Ascension Press) <u>Tuesday Mornings</u>, <u>9AM- 11AM</u> in the <u>Gathering Space/ Library- - Starts on Sept. 19th</u>

This study is a prayerful meditation with Scripture (Lectio Divina), where you will be drawn into an intimate and life-changing encounter with Christ. Daring to Walk the Walk introduces seven key virtues and outlines practical steps for living them out in daily life. This study shows how to put our Catholic faith into practice through prayer and action. The result is real, often-profound change occurring in people's lives as they begin living as God intended them to. (Part 2 of this series will start in Jan. 2024) **Cost: \$25**

Matthew: The King and His Kingdom: (24 sessions, will cont. into 2024- Ascension Press) <u>Tuesday Mornings, 9AM- 11AM</u> in the <u>Youth Center, Rm. B-</u> (Childcare can be provided)- Starts on **Sept. 5th**

This study shows how Jesus fulfills God's promises to Israel and establishes his kingdom on earth. Through references to the Old Testament promises of God to his people and the messages God sent them through the prophets, this Bible study provides the key to understanding the rest of the New Testament and Christ as the fulfillment of God's plan. Matthew portrays Jesus as the true King who fulfills the Law the people of Israel have failed to keep and who introduces the new law that will accompany the New Covenant. In this 24-part study of Matthew's Gospel, Jeff Cavins explains how Jesus is challenging and empowering us to a new level of holiness and shows how we must be thoroughly immersed in the kingdom of heaven on earth, the Church, to live it. Epic: The Early Church encourages you to grow closer to Christ through a deeper understanding of his Church. Here you will get to know the people and events that shaped its first five hundred years. You will see how the Church Fathers boldly confronted early challenges to the Faith—challenges similar to the ones we face today. You will learn the stories behind the first ecumenical councils and the Roman persecutions and meet many of the men and women who gave their lives to defend the Faith. The heroic stories of the early leaders and martyrs of the Church will strengthen and affirm your own walk of faith. Cost: \$30

Psalms: The School of Prayer: (11 Sessions- Ascension Press) Thursday Nights, 6:30PM- 8:30PM on Zoom- - Starts on Sept. 21st

The Holy Spirit inspired them. Israel sang them. Christ himself prayed them as did our Blessed Mother. At the heart of the Bible are the Psalms, prayers from God that help us to pray. In the *Psalms*, discover how these sacred hymns become our heartfelt response to God's loving and wondrous deeds for us. In this Bible study, presenters Jeff Cavins, Tim Gray, and Sarah Christmyer show you how to establish a deeply personal dialogue with God through the Psalms. Learn how to meditate fruitfully on the captivating words of the Psalms using Lectio Divina and study the many ways the Psalms foretell the life and mission of Jesus. **Cost: \$30**
