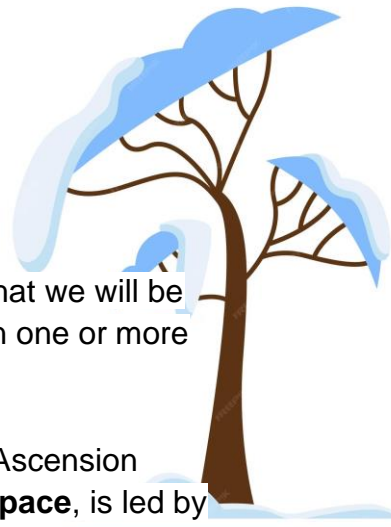


Winter/ Spring 2024 Bible Studies
