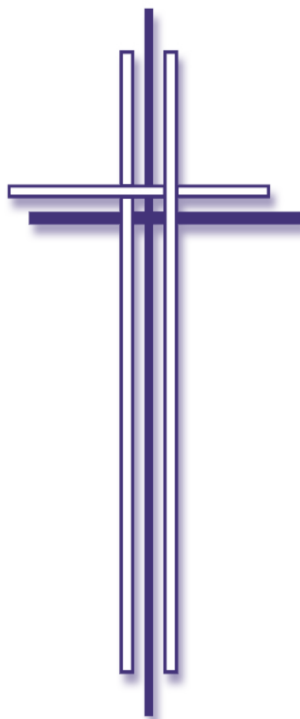

Welcome! If you are new in the parish, please introduce yourself after Mass and arrange to register with us; online at www.ckparish.org or in the office during business hours. We're glad you're here!

Sacrament of Baptism: is scheduled by appointment only; parents must have been registered members of the parish for at least 2 months and must participate in Baptismal Instruction (offered through FORMED).

Sacrament of the Sick: In the event of serious illness or medical emergency, Anointing and Eucharist may be arranged. Call the parish office during office hours, or the emergency number after hours. Contact the Visitation Ministry Office to arrange for home visits.

Celebration of Christian Funeral: After the death of a loved one, you may contact the Parish Office at your earliest convenience to arrange for a date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Sacrament of Marriage: Engaged couples requesting information about matrimony must contact and meet with one of the priests or deacons at least 4 months before the proposed wedding date and should expect to participate in a marriage preparation program.

Christian Initiation of Adults: Adults requesting information about full initiation into the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation) may contact the RCIA Coordinator at 371-0994.

Christian Initiation of Children (CIC): We offer a program for older children who have not been baptized or received their First Communion. Call the Religious Education Office at 946-1154 for information.

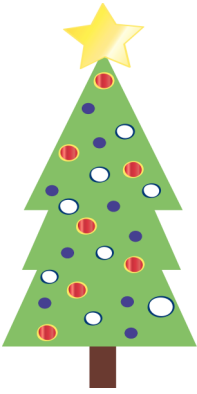

St. Vincent de Paul Food Baskets and Parish Sharing Tree



If you have been reading the bulletin, you know that the Food Basket and Sharing Tree will be celebrated "pandemic style" again this year. But pandemic style or not, the families we serve (St. Vincent de Paul families, Elijah Family Homes children and Catholic Charities seniors, foster kids and others) will still be in need.

Due to COVID, we must eliminate all gathering events that support these two projects. The school children will not be collecting food, parish families will not be collecting toys and games, or going out to deliver them. Rather, BOTH PRO-

JECTS ARE GOING ALL GIFT CARDS. Instead of food and toiletries, we will provide gift cards and rely on each of our needy families to shop for their own holiday groceries. Instead of toys, games, and other gifts, we will provide gift cards to parents and rely on them to shop for their children.

We hope that instead of shopping for food or toys that you will instead, purchase gift cards that we can distribute safely on your behalf. Although it won't be as much fun, we have tried to make participating as easy and contact-free as possible. If you use online giving (<https://osvhub.com/CK-parish/funds>), we have set up two accounts -- Food Baskets and Sharing Tree -- so that you can donate right from your computer to either one or both. Our elves will use your donations to purchase the gift cards we need most.

If you buy your own gift cards, we are asking for denominations of \$25 or less. We really appreciate gift cards from grocery stores, especially WinCo, or grocery/gift stores like Fred Meyer, Walmart, or Target. Please make sure the amount on each card appears somewhere on the card. If you attend Mass in person, you can give your cards to an Usher/Greeter before Mass. You can also bring them to the church office, drop them in the silver "MAIL" slot that is in the wall to the right of the office door or send them through the mail to CK Church, 1111 Stevens Dr., Richland, WA 99354. CK students can turn them in at school.

However you choose to give, we need your donation early in order to allow families time to shop.

Sunday Reflection

God's Personal Assistants

If you have ever planned a large-scale event, whether it's a musical performance or a religious conference, you may have dealt with someone's personal assistant. Possibly this person would be a representative of the keynote speaker or the master of ceremonies for the local bishop; perhaps it's even the staffer of a local politician or the lackey of a well-known musical act.

Personal assistants are masters of stewardship — overseeing things in their boss' absence. They prepare the way. This person's job is to get everything ready for the person in charge, so that when he or she shows up — whoever he or she is — it's smooth sailing for them to do whatever it is they need to do: sing, speak, pray, mingle, what-have-you. It's usually a big job full of little things, a gig where attention to detail is key.

God is the guest of honor in our life, the keynote speaker, the main event. And what He wants — what He needs — to do is to change our hearts. Constantly, over, and over, and over again.

We are all His personal assistants in this endeavor. We need to prepare the way of the Lord, to make straight His paths. We need to make everything ready so that when He shows up — however He shows up, whether it's in the form of a neighbor in need or a burning bush right in front of us — everything is ready for Him to do His job.

Spiritual Practices

Ignatian Spirituality

Our world is full of suffering and evil. The Christian term for this disorder is sin. In his autobiography, Ignatius described himself as scrupulous about his sinfulness. The only way he could escape his scrupulosity was to embrace the mercy of God. He explained that sin can be seen through two prisms: 1) Lack of gratitude in the face of God’s continuing gifts. 2) Lack of reverence for God. During Advent, the church, as well as the Spiritual Exercises, focus on sin and forgiveness, and preparing for Christ’s coming. Through prayer, we try to uncover ways that we lack reverence or gratitude - how we are pulled from God toward self. As we do so, the Spiritual Exercises direct us to ask for two graces: Shame that we’ve hurt God through our sinfulness, and confusion that we could still sin, even as we are so loved.

The next meeting of the Spiritual Exercises in Everyday Life (SEEL) will be Dec. 11 at 9 a.m. online. The theme will be the Kingdom of God. To learn more about SEEL visit <http://spiritual-exercises.com>

Blessed John Soreth (died 1471), Memorial July 24; from the Exhortation on the Carmelite Rule

It is from Christ himself that you will learn how to love him. Learn to love him tenderly, with all your heart; prudently, with all your soul; fervently, with all your strength. Love him tenderly, so that you will not be seduced away from him; prudently, so that you will not be open to deception; and fervently, so that downheartedness will not draw you away from God’s love. May the wisdom of Christ seem sweet to you, so that you are not led away by the glory of the world and the pleasures of the flesh. May Christ, who is the Truth, enlighten you, so that you do not fall prey to the spirit of error and falsehood. May Christ, who is the Strength of God, fortify you when hardships wear you out.
