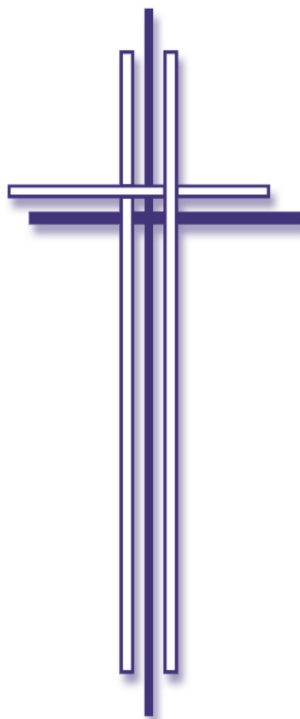

**Welcome!** If you are new in the parish, please introduce yourself after Mass and arrange to register with us; online at [www.ckparish.org](http://www.ckparish.org) or in the office during business hours. We're glad you're here!

**Sacrament of Baptism:** is scheduled by appointment only; parents must have been registered members of the parish for at least 2 months and must participate in Baptismal Instruction (offered on the 1st Wednesday of the month in the Bride's Room).

**Sacrament of the Sick:** In the event of serious illness or medical emergency, Anointing and Eucharist may be arranged. Call the parish office during office hours, or the emergency number after hours. Contact the Visitation Ministry Office to arrange for home visits.

**Celebration of Christian Funeral:** After the death of a loved one, you may contact the Parish Office at your earliest convenience to arrange for a date and time for the funeral liturgy.

**Sacrament of Marriage:** Engaged couples requesting information about matrimony must contact and meet with one of the priests or deacons at least 4 months before the proposed wedding date and should expect to participate in a marriage preparation program.

**Christian Initiation of Adults:** Adults requesting information about full initiation into the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation) may contact the RCIA Coordinator at 371-0994.

**Christian Initiation of Children (CIC):** We offer a program for older children who have not been baptized or received their First Communion. Call the Religious Education Office at 946-1154 for information.

### Sunday Reflection

#### Loving as New Creations

"There's something different about you."

Think about the times in your life when this has been said to you. Maybe it was after someone complimented you on a job well done, and you realized that you were walking through life with a little more confidence. Maybe it was after meeting someone special, as you carried the glow of that relationship wherever you went. Chances are, if someone has noticed something different about you, it's because, inwardly, you've been changed by the loving or respectful actions of another person.

Love, you see, can make us into new creations. From the love of God flows the grace to tackle any challenge, including the biggest challenge of all: loving each other well. Christ knows what a big request this is. He was human, too. He came and lived among us. He knew intimately what it was to love people in the chaos of their own flaws. He knew what he was asking of us when he said, "As I have loved you, so you should also love one another."

In essence, this is the call to stewardship: loving as Christ loves, amidst the messiness of everyday reality. Loving with accountability, challenging ourselves and our brothers and sisters to be faithful even when it is hard. Loving with an unflinching sense of hospitality that welcomes even those we do not agree with or understand. Loving with gratitude, giving thanks for the great variety of ways that Christ can make himself known to us through others.

## Eucharistic Miracles

### Eucharistic Miracles of the World!

St. Satyrus (Italy, 4th century) is our Eucharistic Miracle saint for the week. St. Ambrose (his brother) wrote of him "Before being fully initiated into the sublime mysteries (First Communion), he experienced a shipwreck... while all round the waves were tearing [his ship] apart, he was not afraid of dying but of having to leave his life without having been nourished by [the Eucharist]... So he asked for the Eucharist...and placed [it] in a handkerchief, which he hung around his neck. Then he threw himself into the sea and looked for a plank loosed from the hulk of the ship to hang onto..." (The Eucharistic Miracles of the World, 329) He did indeed reach land and when realizing he was saved went straight to the closest church to receive his First Holy Communion.

New miracles are on display in the Gathering Space including some from Santerem, Portugal; Caravaca, Spain; and Bordeaux, France!
