**Sacrament of Baptism:** is scheduled by appointment only; parents must have been registered members of the parish for at least 2 months and must attend a Baptismal Instruction Class offered at 7:00 p.m. the first Wednesday of each month.

**Sacrament of the Sick:** In the event of serious illness or medical emergency, Anointing and Eucharist may be arranged. Call the parish office during office hours, or the emergency number after hours. Contact the Visitation Ministry Office to arrange for home visits.

**Celebration of Christian Funeral:** After the death of a loved one, you may contact the Parish Office at your earliest convenience to arrange for a date and time for the funeral liturgy.

**Sacrament of Marriage:** Engaged couples requesting information about matrimony must contact and meet with one of the priests or deacons at least 4 months before the proposed wedding date and should expect to participate in a marriage preparation program.

**Christian Initiation of Adults:** Adults requesting information about full initiation into the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation) may contact the RCIA Coordinator at 371-0994.

**Christian Initiation of Children (CIC):** We offer a program for older children who have not been baptized or received their First Communion. Call the Religious Education Office at 946-1154 for information.

**Indoor Mass Attendance Protocols:** We are continuing to do our best to keep everyone as safe as possible. We require everyone at Mass to wear a mask, even those who are vaccinated. Please take care to sit six feet away from others not in your household, and allow space as you process to Communion.

If you have not been vaccinated, please do so. The vaccine, along with masking, is our best weapon against this disease. And as always, if you are ill with anything contagious, please stay home!

**About COVID-19 Vaccines:** "Getting vaccinated is an act of love," says Pope Francis.

The church has consistently counseled that we all have a moral obligation to protect each other from this highly contagious virus. We are asked to isolate if we are sick, to keep our hands clean and avoid unnecessary contact, to maintain a safe distance from others, and, yes, now that we have a vaccine, to receive it.

All of these measures involve a choice on our part. We do have free will, and the church does not challenge our right to choose. However, choices carry consequences. A choice that puts personal conviction as a higher good than caring for others may mean that we contribute to the spread of disease, limit availability of health care because our hospitals are full of COVID patients, experience mandates because voluntary cooperation is insufficient, and lose employment or inclusion in some settings.

The vaccine is effective, safe, and free. **Please** do your part to help limit transmission.

### Giving as God does

Ask yourself this question — what would you pray for if you really believed God could and would do anything for you? In my experience, we all have something. We all have that miracle we're afraid to request, afraid we will be disappointed.

Do we doubt God's readiness to give because we ourselves have such an imperfect understanding of charity and love? Maybe if we had better faith in God we would be more ready to give of ourselves — and maybe if we were more ready to give of ourselves, we would understand more clearly the ways of God.

Because we're not really afraid that God can't do something. We know He can do anything. What we're afraid of is that He will do what He always does: give us what we need, not what we want.

Have you ever had a friend in need and you just wanted to give them something — a meal, a phone call, a text? Not because you knew it would help, but simply because you wanted to reach out. And have they ever said to you: It wasn't so much what you gave, but the fact that you did. You gave them what they needed even if it wasn't what they specifically asked for.

When we give in this manner, we are giving as God does. Sometimes we are afraid to ask because we don't want to be disappointed. But remember, the blind man on the road got what he asked for, but he would have gotten what he needed even if his answer had been the opposite. God's generosity is always reckless, and it's always perfect.

**Ignatian Spirituality**

Only one thing causes unhappiness: attachment. But what does this mean? St. Ignatius, in his Spiritual Exercises, says that an attachment is an emotional state of clinging caused by the belief that without some particular thing or some person you cannot be happy." This, he goes on to say, is composed of two parts: 1) the flash of pleasure and excitement you experience when you get what you're attached to. And 2) the sense of threat and tension you feel, worried you might not get it again, or might lose it. By its nature, then, an attachment opens a person to emotional turmoil, and threatens peace.

Excerpts from **St. Joseph, Patron of Carmel:** by Prior General, Miceál O'Neill, O Carm. and Superior General, Saverio Cannistrà, OCD; *The Sword*, V80, #2, 2020

With the sensitivity that is typical of the Carmelite contemplative charism, the ancient liturgy celebrated the purity of the Blessed Virgin and of St. Joseph, by highlighting their openness to God, which made it possible for them to welcome the mystery of the Incarnation. Formed by this liturgical spirituality, St. Mary Magdalen de'Pazzi would see Joseph's protection as a consequence of his purity: "In paradise Joseph's purity joins with the purity of Mary, and in that exchange of splendor, Joseph's purity shines a light on the even greater glory and splendor of Mary's purity. Saint Joseph is in the middle of Jesus and Mary as a resplendent star, and he takes particular care of our monastery because we are under the care of the Virgin Mary."

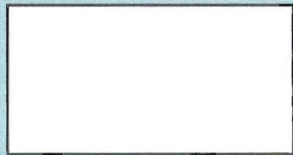
