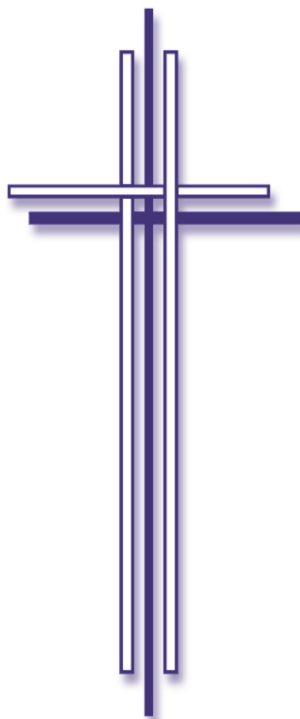

Welcome! If you are new in the parish, please introduce yourself after Mass and arrange to register with us; online at www.ckparish.org or in the office during business hours. We're glad you're here!

Sacrament of Baptism: is scheduled by appointment only; parents must have been registered members of the parish for at least 2 months and must participate in Baptismal Instruction (offered on the 1st Wednesday of the month in the Bride's Room).

Sacrament of the Sick: In the event of serious illness or medical emergency, Anointing and Eucharist may be arranged. Call the parish office during office hours, or the emergency number after hours. Contact the Visitation Ministry Office to arrange for home visits.

Celebration of Christian Funeral: After the death of a loved one, you may contact the Parish Office at your earliest convenience to arrange for a date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Sacrament of Marriage: Engaged couples requesting information about matrimony must contact and meet with one of the priests or deacons at least 4 months before the proposed wedding date and should expect to participate in a marriage preparation program.

Christian Initiation of Adults: Adults requesting information about full initiation into the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation) may contact the RCIA Coordinator at 371-0994.

Christian Initiation of Children (CIC): We offer a program for older children who have not been baptized or received their First Communion. Call the Religious Education Office at 946-1154 for information.

Carmelite Corner

The Carmelites—A Short History

The first General Chapter of the Order was held at Aylesford, Kent, England probably in 1247. The first Prior General was St. Simon Stock, who ruled the Order for 20 years. In 1452, the Prior General, Blessed John Soreth, was authorized by the Papal Bull Cum Nulla to establish Carmelite communities of women. (Laities were members of the Carmelite Order since about 1295, and probably before then.)

The Order gave the assurance that the first and highest aim of the Order, contemplation, was henceforth worthily striven after. The Sisters were called upon to supply what the Friars in the stress and troubles of the pastoral duties in the world were likely to forget: to strengthen and confirm the mystical character.

Blessed John Soreth, by his contemplative prayer life, showed as before, that the contemplation of the law of God remained the chief aim of the Order.

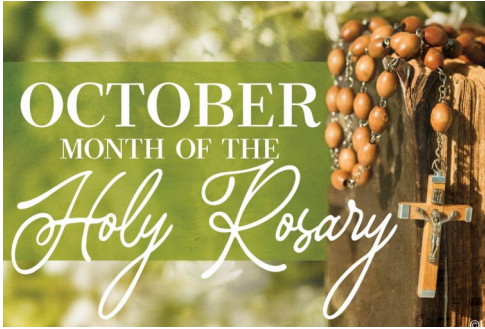
