Sacrament of the Sick: In the event of serious illness or medical emergency, Anointing and Eucharist may be arranged. Call the parish office during office hours, or the emergency number after hours. Contact the Visitation Ministry Office to arrange for home visits.

**Celebration of Christian Funeral:** After the death of a loved one, you may contact the Parish Office at your earliest convenience to arrange for a date and time for the funeral liturgy.

**Sacrament of Marriage:** Engaged couples requesting information about matrimony must contact and meet with one of the priests or deacons at least 4 months before the proposed wedding date and should expect to participate in a marriage preparation program.







"St Juliana of Liège...had a vision in which she saw a full moon darkened in one spot. She heard a mysterious heavenly voice state that the moon represented the Church at that time, and the dark spot showed that a great feast in honor of Corpus Christi was missing from the liturgical calendar... [She told] this to the Archdeacon of Liège, Jacques Panteléon, who was later to become Pope Urban IV." (The Eucharistic Miracles of the World, 297)

"Even though the Eucharist is solemnly celebrated every day of the year, on one

day we pay special honor to the Body of Christ. We may, of course, invoke the Lord with our minds and our spirits at any time, but we do not in this way obtain the Real Presence of Christ. With the Eucharistic commemoration, however, Jesus Christ is actually present with us in His own substance. As the risen Christ told us prior to his Ascension: 'And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age' (Mt 29:20)...He would remain and be with them even by his bodily presence" (Pope Urban IV: Transiturus de hoc mundo).
