Celebration of Christian Funeral: After the death of a loved one, you may contact the Parish Office at your earliest convenience to arrange for a date and time for the funeral liturgy.







Ignatian Spirituality

Titus Brandsma to be canonized May 15, 2022

In July 2016, the diocesan inquiry into the presumed miracle obtained through the intercession of Blessed Titus took place in the Diocese of Palm Beach (Florida, USA). The presumed miracle was the healing of Fr. Michael Driscoll, O. Carm., from advanced malignant metastatic melanoma that spread to the lymph nodes. In November 2020, the Medical Consultation, appointed by the Vatican Congregation of the Causes of the Saints, recognized the impossibility of a scientific explanation for the cure of Fr. Driscoll from cancer. The cure was attributed to the intercession of Blessed Titus Brandsma. On May 25, 2021, the Congress of Theological Consultors recognized the miracle. The same opinion was reached by the cardinals and bishops in the Ordinary Session held on November 9, 2021.

Finally, on November 25, 2021, Pope Francis authorized the Congregation of the Causes of the Saints to promulgate the decrees regarding the miracle attributed to the intercession of Blessed Titus Brandsma opening the way to canonization. On March 4, 2022, during the Ordinary Public Consistory, Pope Francis confirmed the opinion of the cardinals and bishops, announcing the date of Fr. Titus' canonization.

Eucharistic Miracles

Eucharistic Miracles of the World!

St. Stanislaus Kostka (Poland 1550-1568) is our focus this week. He was living with a protestant nobleman, who would not allow a Catholic priest to visit. "At about the age of seventeen, Stanislaus became gravely ill. He belonged to the Fraternity of St Barbara, whose members trust their patroness to grant them the grace of Communion at the point of death...One night he awakened...exclaiming 'Here is St Barbara! Here she is with two angels! She's bringing me the Blessed Sacrament!' And so it was, the angels inclined towards him and gave him Holy Communion...a few days later he awoke perfectly healed." (The Eucharistic Miracles of the World, 331). St. Stanislaus is known as the patron saint of novices, youth, young students and seminarians.

New miracles are on display in the Gathering Space including some from Avignon, France; Seefeld, Austria; and Breda, Netherlands! Be sure to stop by.
