Sacrament of Baptism: is scheduled by appointment only; parents must have been registered members of the parish for at least 2 months and must attend a Baptismal Instruction Class offered at 7:00 p.m. the first Wednesday of each month.

Sacrament of the Sick: In the event of serious illness or medical emergency, Anointing and Eucharist may be arranged. Call the parish office during office hours, or the emergency number after hours. Contact the Visitation Ministry Office to arrange for home visits.

Celebration of Christian Funeral: After the death of a loved one, you may contact the Parish Office at your earliest convenience to arrange for a date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Sacrament of Marriage: Engaged couples requesting information about matrimony must contact and meet with one of the priests or deacons at least 4 months before the proposed wedding date and should expect to participate in a marriage preparation program.

Christian Initiation of Adults: Adults requesting information about full initiation into the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation) may contact the RCIA Coordinator at 371-0994.

Christian Initiation of Children (CIC): We offer a program for older children who have not been baptized or received their First Communion. Call the Religious Education Office at 946-1154 for information.

Sunday Reflection

Can You Walk the Walk?

I've met and talked with enough people to feel confident that if you polled 100 fallen-away Catholics about why they didn't want anything to do with the Church, the term "accountability" would pop up in almost all of their answers.

And to be fair, a lack of accountability isn't just a Catholic problem. Talking the talk but not walking the walk has been a shortcoming handed down throughout the ages, across all creeds and nationalities.

Loving our neighbor, welcoming the stranger, clothing the naked, feeding the poor — it all sounds fantastic, especially when we're the ones saying it. But the doing — well, that's a different story, isn't it? We would do well to remember that Christ calls one of his best friends "Satan" when Peter tries to convince Jesus to stray from his destiny.

Have you ever been called Satan by one of your good buddies? I'll bet it's not a great feeling. But think about what Peter was doing. He had just said, "You are the Christ." And now, mere moments later, he's saying: "Don't say these things. Don't say you're going to suffer. Don't say you'll be killed."

He was telling Christ to squander what the Lord had given him. He was telling him that having faith was fine, but being faithful? It's just a little too hard. God has a destiny for you, too, and He's asking you to be open to it. Maybe it's not in your comfort zone. Maybe you don't think you can do it.

Lord, give us faith — but help us, also, to do the work.

Carmelite Corner

Living in God's Presence (8 of 10)

Excerpts from Chapter 9, *Climbing The Mountain, The Carmelite Journey*, St. Albert's Press & Edizioni Carmelitane, 2010

The simplicity of prayer for Brother Lawrence of the Resurrection (1611-91):

The Practice of the Presence of God is a classic of Carmelite wisdom and an international bestseller among both Catholics and Protestants.

Brother Lawrence realized that prayer can become more complicated than it actually needs to be, and we don't need to use a lot of words.... (He said) "I keep myself in his presence by simple attentiveness and a general loving awareness of God" (letter 2)

Lawrence appreciated that prayer is, quite simply, a process of turning our hearts to God in acknowledgment of his presence. This might be for a prolonged period, or just a few seconds, and gradually helps us acquire the habitual attitude of being aware that we are always in God's presence. Prayer is God's country that we gradually explore. We must put ourselves into his care and allow him to arrange things for us. Prayer is always possible, no matter what we feel like, because God is actually the one reaching out to us before we ever reach out to him. Sometimes offering our emptiness and dryness is enough.
