Joining in dialogue in Church and in wider society

To what extent do diverse peoples in our community come together for dialogue? Where are the places this happens?

Participating in ecumenism

What relationships does our Parish have with members of other Christian denominations?

Each claiming their proper authority and participation

How does our Church identify goals, the ways to reach them, and encourage participation?

Being part of discerning and deciding

What methods do we use in decision-making – can they be improved?

How does our Church form people to be more capable of 'walking together,' listening to one another, participating in mission, and engaging in dialogue?
