Welcome! If you are new in the parish, please introduce yourself after Mass and arrange to register with us; online at www.ckparish.org or in the office during business hours. We're glad you're here!

Sacrament of Baptism: is scheduled by appointment only; parents must have been registered members of the parish for at least 4 months and must participate in Baptismal Instruction (offered on the 1st Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. in the Bride's Room). Registration for the class is required.

Sacrament of the Sick: In the event of serious illness or medical emergency, Anointing and Eucharist may be arranged. Call the parish office during office hours, or the emergency number after hours. Contact the Visitation Ministry Office to arrange for home visits.

Celebration of Christian Funeral: After the death of a loved one, you may contact the Parish Office at your earliest convenience to arrange for a date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Sacrament of Marriage: Engaged couples requesting that their wedding take place at Christ the King must fill out an application (available on our website or in the parish office). The application must be submitted at least 4 months before the proposed wedding date to allow time for marriage preparation. The form includes information about fees.

Christian Initiation of Adults: Adults requesting information about full initiation into the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation) may contact the OCIA Coordinator at 371-0994.

Christian Initiation of Children (CIC): We offer a program for older children who have not been baptized or received their First Communion. Call the Religious Education Office at 946-1675 for information.

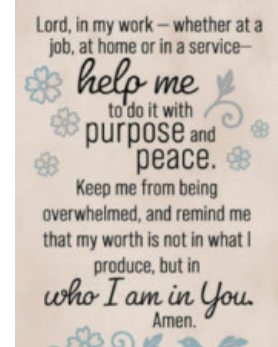

Payments above our goal will be returned to the parish and benefit our budget! Please keep the payments coming in!

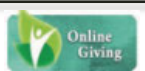

In and Around the Diocese

Religious Workforce Protection Act: Twin bills have been introduced to the U.S. House and Senate, HR.2672 and S.1298 both titled Religious Workforce Protection Act.

These bills amend immigration laws to allow religious workers to request a renewal of their visas without having to leave the country for a year. One way you can help our immigrant priests is to write to Rep. Dan Newhouse and Sen. Maria Cantwell and let them know you urge them to support these bills.

A Note from the Serra Club

Do you want to carry the fire of the Lord to His people as a priest, permanent deacon, sister, or brother?
