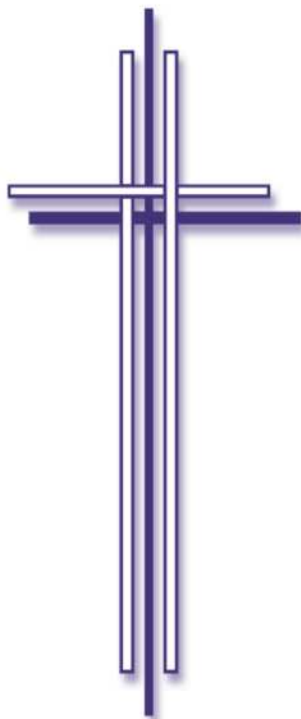

Welcome! If you are new in the parish, please introduce yourself after Mass and arrange to register with us; online at www.ckparish.org or in the office during business hours. We're glad you're here!

Sacrament of Baptism: is scheduled by appointment only; parents must have been registered members of the parish for at least 4 months and must participate in Baptismal Instruction (offered on the 1st Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. in the Bride's Room). Registration for the class is required.

Sacrament of the Sick: In the event of serious illness or medical emergency, Anointing and Eucharist may be arranged. Call the parish office during office hours, or the emergency number after hours. Contact the Visitation Ministry Office to arrange for home visits.

Celebration of Christian Funeral: After the death of a loved one, you may contact the Parish Office at your earliest convenience to arrange for a date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Sacrament of Marriage: Engaged couples requesting that their wedding take place at Christ the King must fill out an application (available on our website or in the parish office). The application must be submitted at least 4 months before the proposed wedding date to allow time for marriage preparation. The form includes information about fees.

Christian Initiation of Adults: Adults requesting information about full initiation into the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation) may contact the OCIA Coordinator at 371-0994.

Christian Initiation of Children (CIC): We offer a program for older children who have not been baptized or received their First Communion. Call the Religious Education Office at 946-1675 for information.

From our St. Vincent de Paul Society

In today's Gospel, Jesus lays out the demands of following him, the great cost of discipleship. The Mission Statement of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul states: "Vincetians witness God's love by embracing all works of charity and justice...the Society makes no distinction in those served because, in them, Vincetians see the face of Christ."

Blessed Frederic Ozanam was one of the founders of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul. Frederic approached his ministry centered on Jesus's teachings, his devotion to the Blessed Sacrament and for our blessed Mother Mary. While continuing as a member of the Society for his entire life, he also founded a newspaper, *L'ere Nouvelle*, in 1848 in which he published commentary on social issues and social justice, giving voice to the views he had formed while serving the poor. Frederic passed away on September 8, the feast day of the birthday of the Blessed Mother, and his feast day is celebrated on September 9.

Do you sometimes feel that you should be doing more to grow in your spiritual life? If so, you may be hearing the call to Vincentian fellowship. The Christ the King Conference provides an excellent organization in which you can grow spiritually as well as using your talents to address some physical and spiritual needs of others in our community. Carmelite Corner

Excerpts from *Nine Themes in Carmelite Spirituality*, Fr. Patrick McMahon, O. Carm., www.ocarm.org
Carmel is Marian, continued.

Carmel offers a Christocentric spirituality in which Mary plays a key, but supportive, role. The Carmelite celebrates his or her devotion to Mary primarily by means of imitation of the Blessed Virgin. That is why we often reflect in our meditation on the mystery of salvation from Mary's point of view. We don't reflect on Mary. We reflect on Jesus as Mary saw him. We often, but not always, approach the Incarnation, for example, from Mary's perspective. What is it like for an angel to come to Mary? In what ways does God's angel come to me? What did it mean for Mary to say yes to God's request? What does it mean for me to say yes to God's request?

Or, how did Mary feel when she saw Her son naked and bleeding and dying on the cross? What was it like when the risen Lord came to his mother? Where and in what ways does the risen Lord come to me? The possibilities for prayerfully seeing Christ through the eyes of his mother are endless, and the Carmelite often turns toward them.

For the Carmelite, Mary is always offering Jesus to us—Jesus, whom our Rule calls our only Savior. The Carmelite knows and always remembers that Jesus is our only hope, our only mediator of salvation, our only intercessor with God the Father. The Carmelite always looks at Mary smiling as she puts your hand into the hand of her Son. And as she sees your gaze turn from her to him and the love that you have for him come alive in your heart as it has in hers ever since that moment when the angel gave his greeting.
