**Welcome!** If you are new in the parish, please introduce yourself after Mass and arrange to register with us; online at <a href="https://www.ckparish.org">www.ckparish.org</a> or in the office during business hours. We're glad you're here!

**Sacrament of Baptism:** is scheduled by appointment only; parents must have been registered members of the parish for at least 4 months and must participate in Baptismal Instruction (offered on the 1st Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. in the Bride's Room). Registration for the class is required.

**Sacrament of the Sick:** In the event of serious illness or medical emergency, Anointing and Eucharist may be arranged. Call the parish office during office hours, or the emergency number after hours. Contact the Visitation Ministry Office to arrange for home visits.

**Celebration of Christian Funeral:** After the death of a loved one, you may contact the Parish Office at your earliest convenience to arrange for a date and time for the funeral liturgy.

**Sacrament of Marriage:** Engaged couples requesting that their wedding take place at Christ the King must fill out an application (available on our website or in the parish office). The application must be submitted at least 4 months before the proposed wedding date to allow time for marriage preparation. The form includes information about fees.

Christian Initiation of Adults: Adults requesting information about full initiation into the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation) may contact the OCIA Coordinator at 371-0994.

**Christian Initiation of Children (CIC):** We offer a program for older children who have not been baptized or received their First Communion. Call the Religious Education Office at 946-1675 for information.



You may know about the 'O Antiphons' that are prayed, from Dec. 17 to Dec. 24 with the Canticle of Mary in Evening Prayer of the Divine Office. There are also specific antiphons for the Canticle of Zechariah prayed during Morning prayer.

Here are several from a Benedictine breviary published by St. John's Abbey in Minnesota:

- Dec. 21: There is no need to be afraid; in five days our Lord will come to us. Alleluia.
- Dec. 23: All that God promised to the Virgin through the message of the angel has been accomplished. Alleluia.
- Dec. 24: This day you will know that the Lord is coming, and tomorrow you will see his glory. Alleluia.


