Bishop of Spokane

Charles Daniel White (1943 – 1951)

Christ the King was established as a mission church to St. Joseph's Parish in Kennewick, WA which was part of the **Spokane Diocese**. Christ the King became its own parish on July 1, 1946, still part of the **Spokane Diocese**.

Bishops of Yakima

Joseph Patrick Dougherty (1951–1969)

The Diocese of Yakima is established June 3, 1951.

Cornelius Michael Power (1969 –1974)

Appointed Archbishop of the Portland, Oregon Archdiocese, 1974

Nicolas Eugene Walsh (1974 –1976)

William Stephen Skylstad (1977–1990)

Appointed Bishop of Spokane Diocese, 1990

Francis George, O.M.I. (1990 –1996)

Appointed Archbishop of Portland, Oregon in 1996, later Archbishop of Chicago in 1997 and elevated to Cardinal in 1998.
